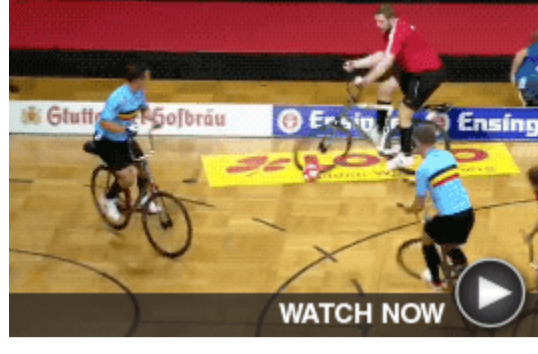

### How To Protect Yourself From Telecom Fraud

As more and more people adopt telecom devices into their day to day lives, the need for vigilant fraud protection is vital. The rise in telecom fraud has increased tenfold in Ontario over the past few years. These pervasive frauds affect people of all ages; however, seniors and new Canadians are most likely to be affected.



Recently we have heard a few complaints from Nexicom customers stating they have received telephone calls from would-be fraudsters claiming to be Nexicom employees. When the caller identifies themselves, they state "Hello my name is (insert fictitious name), and I am calling today on behalf of the Nexicom Billing department. Our records show that your account is currently in collections, and we will be shutting off your services immediately if we do not receive payment today!"

To sound more official the fraudsters then lists their employee badge number. Please be aware that Nexicom will never provide an employee badge number when contacting any of our customers. As per Nexicom's Accounts Receivable policy, a customer would only be contacted via telephone and/or email. The customer would only be contacted if their account shows an overdue balance of 30 days or more for internet services, 60 days or more for telephone services, or to notify of a returned payment. If no one is available to answer the call we will leave our name, and either our Billing department telephone number (705) 775-6394, or our Accounts Receivable department telephone number (705) 932-4132.

In all cases our Billing and/or Accounts Receivable departments will notify any account in arrears to politely request payment, and work with the client to arrange for a payment schedule that meets their financial situation. Nexicom will never contact a client and demand immediate payment or suspension of services without prior notification. The Accounts Receivable Representative will identify themselves as being from Nexicom. They will request to speak to the person(s) name on the account, and for security purposes ask the account holder one or two personal security questions to establish proper identification.

If you believe this contact to be untruthful, we recommend that you hang up, and call back to contact either our Billing or Collections departments phone numbers. If there is a caller ID number from the fraudulent call please take a copy and provide it to us when you call us back. We will provide the number to the appropriate police services fraud department for further investigation.

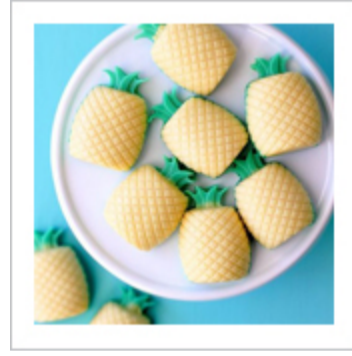

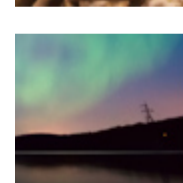

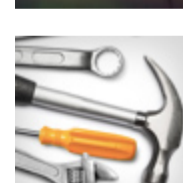
**Google Street View**
